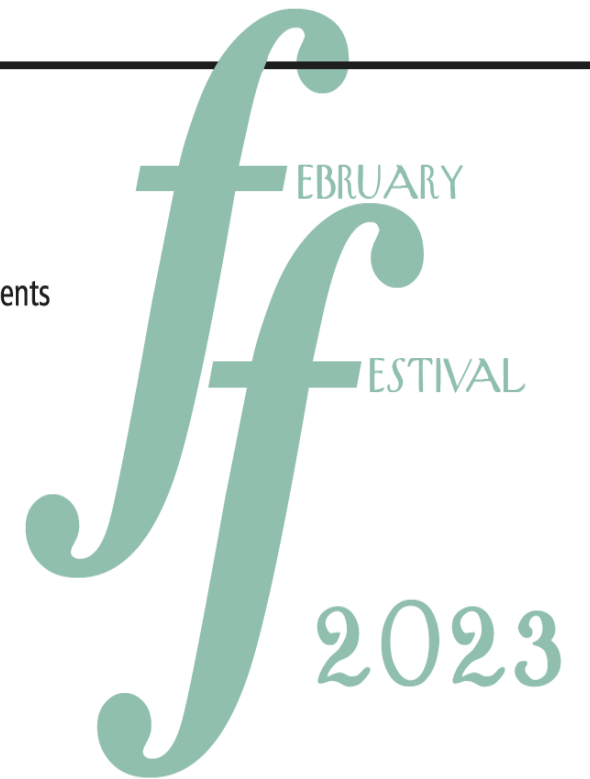

Anna Bogolubova

Anna Bogolubova is one of the leading pianists/composers in Ukraine. In addition to her many television and radio performances, she was featured on a National TV Ukraine documentary – “Anna Bogolubova – Composer and Pianist.” She has performed solo recitals in the USA, Canada, Mexico, Austria, Germany, Andorra, Italy, Poland, Russia, and the Ukraine. First Prize competition wins include: XX Incontro Internazionale Giovani Pianisti Citta Di Senegalis, Italy; Concorso Internacional de Piano, Andorra; The Music and Art Foundation Young Musicians Piano Competition, New York; New York Chopin Competition; BC Pops Competition; Richard Youth Concerto Competition in Binghamton, New York, and most recently Concorso Internacional de Piano Parnassos in Mexico.

After her highly successful solo debut at the age of 8 in the famous Odessa Philharmonic Hall, Anna was admitted to the Stolyarsky Music School where she was under the patronage of Anatoly Kardashef. At the age of 10 Anna was selected to perform Beethoven’s 2nd Piano Concerto under the direction of Garry Oganezov, launching her in a performing career through her native country. She holds both Bachelor and Master’s Degrees from The Juilliard School for the Performing Arts and studied with Oxana Yablonskaya.

In August 2007, Naxos released a CD of her performing two concertos by H. K. Hedley with Russia Philharmonic Orchestra, conductor Dmitry Yablonsky. She has over twenty years of pedagogic experience teaching privately and in schools such as The Lycee Francais de New York and the Hovnanian School. She has been invited to give Master Classes in several countries and has been a judge of international piano competitions. In 2010, she co-founded BOMAA (Beauty of Music and Art) in New York City.
