Aimee Toner

Flutist Aimee Toner performs and teaches throughout the northeast, including performances with the Enigma Chamber Opera Orchestra, Norwalk Symphony, Du Bois Symphony, and the Glens Falls Symphony. She has collaborated with chamber groups ranging from jazz trios in Italian restaurants to wind quintets on stage at Carnegie Hall. Aimee holds a Master of Music degree from the New England Conservatory, and is also a graduate of Barnard College where she majored in Ethnomusicology and Economics. She serves as faculty at the Rhode Island Philharmonic Music School, and as manager of the Brockton Symphony Orchestra’s Marketing and Fundraising Initiatives.

Mia Venezia

Mia Venezia is a professional harpist based in the New Haven and Philadelphia areas. She began studying music at age 5 and is currently pursuing a master’s degree in harp performance from Yale University. Previously, she studied at Northwestern University with the Lyric Opera of Chicago principal harpist Lynn Williams, and at Carnegie Mellon University with Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra principal harpist Gretchen Van Hoesen. She has performed with the New Haven Symphony, Pittsburgh Symphony Orchestra, Chamber Orchestra of Pittsburgh, and the Northwest Indiana Symphony Orchestra. She is a member of the prize winning flute, viola, and harp ensemble, Tartan Trio. A passionate educator, Mia has a private studio in which she hopes to inspire and foster the next generation of harpists.
